

Locating Your **MASTER VALVE**

The master valve is probably the most important piece of your internal plumbing system. It controls the flow of water throughout your property. You and everyone in your household should know where the master valve is and be able to locate it in a moment's notice. If your property is going to be unoccupied for a long period of time, you might want to consider shutting the valve off to avoid or minimize any water emergencies during your absence. In addition, a plumber can drain your lines if the property will be subjected to below freezing temperatures . The most probable locations for the master valve are where the water supply pipe enters your home or at the meter, if it is inside your property.
