

At Aqua Illinois, water quality and customer service are our highest priorities. Since acquiring the system in 2013, Aqua has invested in infrastructure and other water quality and wastewater improvements.

To pay for these improvements, Aqua has filed with the Illinois Commerce Commission (ICC) for a rate increase. If this rate is granted in full as filed, an average combined monthly residential water and wastewater bill (4,500 gallons) would increase by \$22.01, (\$0.73 per day) to \$129.44, including fire protection charges.

The following chart provides examples of typical household monthly water and wastewater usage and anticipated rate increases for Sun River Terrace customers.

- Overall systems improvements: wastewater main replacements, repair and/or replacement of damaged and leaking manholes.
