

Aqua Indiana-Western Hancock, Inc. Southeastern Utilities Division

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that on or about May 18, 2018, Aqua Indiana-Western Hancock, Inc. (the “Company”) will submit a proposed change to its Rules and Regulations for Sewage Disposal Service (“Rules”) to the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (“Commission”) for approval under its 30-Day Filing procedures, 170 IAC 1-6-1, *et seq.* The submittal will be made in connection with the Company’s Thirty Day Filing # 50140, filed on March 26, 2018. The Company will seek Commission approval of a change to its Rules regarding main extension costs, which would allow an applicant to pay the cost of a main extension exclusive of the tax associated with the main extension. The referenced filing will affect only those Company customers in its Southeastern Utilities Division located in Marion County, Indiana.

A copy of the proposed changes to the Rules will be on file with the Commission on or about May 18, 2018. A decision on the 30-Day Filing is anticipated at least thirty days after May 18, 2018.
